



Active Classroom provides robust integration with Google Classroom

Integration includes the ability to:

- Roster Google Classroom students and classes into your Active Classroom account
- Sync the platforms at any time to update rosters for classes and students
- Create assignments in Active Classroom that are automatically added to your Google courses
- Launch assignments in Active Classroom by clicking on the assignment link in Google Classroom
- Use the “sign in with Google option” for Single Sign On access to Active Classroom. No additional usernames or passwords to remember
- Review grades published in Active Classroom in your Google Classroom gradebook

ROSTERING

A teacher that connects their Active Classroom (AC) account to their Google Classroom (GC) account will have their GC classes pulled into AC. Teachers can still manage and create classes manually in AC, but classes created manually in AC (and assignments to those classes) will not transfer to Google Classroom.

Any changes to classes that are made in GC (adding/removing students, renaming classes) will occur in AC as well. Changes to classes that are made in AC, will not transfer to GC.

If district is already being rostered through OneRoster files, but teachers also want to connect AC and GC, this **must be coordinated between the district's IT department and teachers** – if not, teachers may end up with extra classes or duplicated students. If student emails in OneRoster files and Google Classroom do not match, duplicated user accounts will be created.

ASSIGNMENT INTEGRATION

Teacher's assignments in AC will be sent to GC as "course work" for their students.

AC will push into GC only those assignments, which are *assigned to GC classes*. If a teacher creates an assignment for a non-GC class/student/group, this assignment will not be sent to GC when the sync occurs.

While the teacher's account is connected to GC, creating an assignment in AC will automatically create an assignment in GC, as long as the assignment is created for a GC class in AC. An assignment created for an individual student, or a non-GC class will not be created in GC.

The GC assignment will contain a link to the AC assignment and the instructions entered when creating the AC assignment (if any). Editing a GC-linked assignment in AC will update that assignment in GC.

If for any reason AC is unable to send the assignment to GC (e.g. network or Google service down), the AC assignment will still be created, and the teacher will get a warning to synchronize the assignment manually.

If the student is working on an AC assignment connected to a GC assignment, once the student submits the assignment in AC, it will also be marked as submitted in GC. (If for any reason AC is unable to update the assignment's status in GC, the AC assignment will still be submitted in AC and the student will need to manually synchronize their assignments to GC.)

None of the students' answers, attachments, or annotations are sent from AC to GC.

GRADE PASSBACK

Students grades and assignment status ('turned in') will be sent from AC into GC. Students must still go into AC to complete their assignments there, but when turning in their work in AC, the corresponding course work in GC will be updated too.

AC will push student grades into GC for those assignments with student progress that has been graded.

GC requires grades to be numeric. All grades sent to GC will be converted to a 0-100 scale. They will remain unchanged in AC.

Connecting AC-GC for teachers

1. Login to Active Classroom

Go to [our login page](#) and click "Log in with Google".

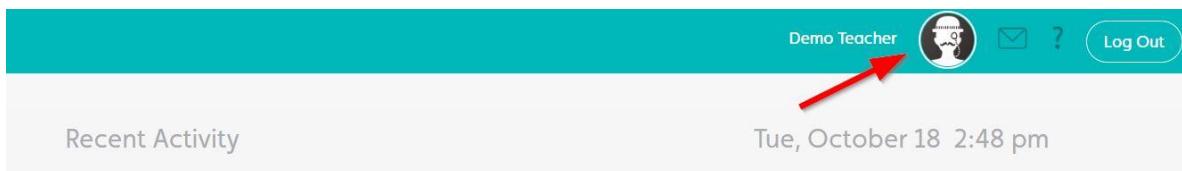
Make sure to login with the email address that is also registered for your Google Classroom account.

If your district has SSO you can also login with Clever or ClassLink.

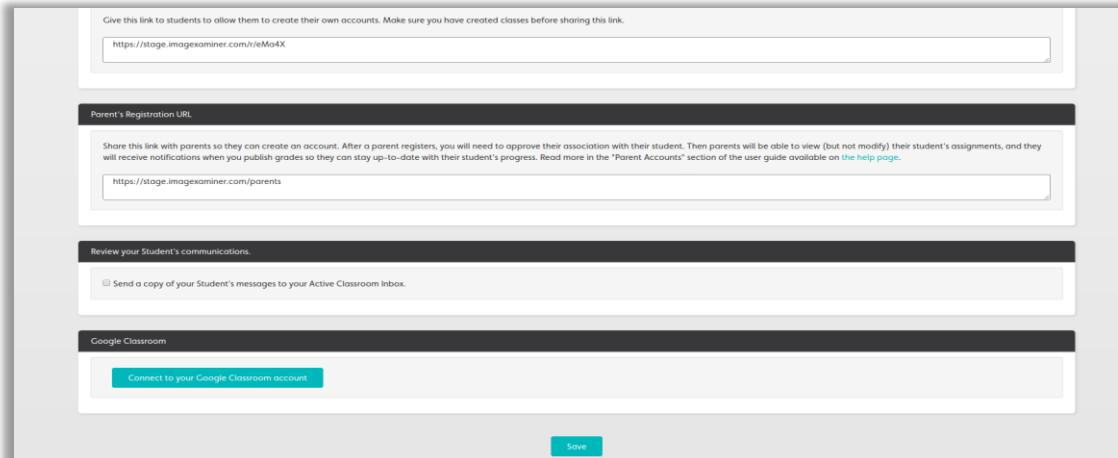


2. Connect your account with Google Classroom

Go to your user profile.



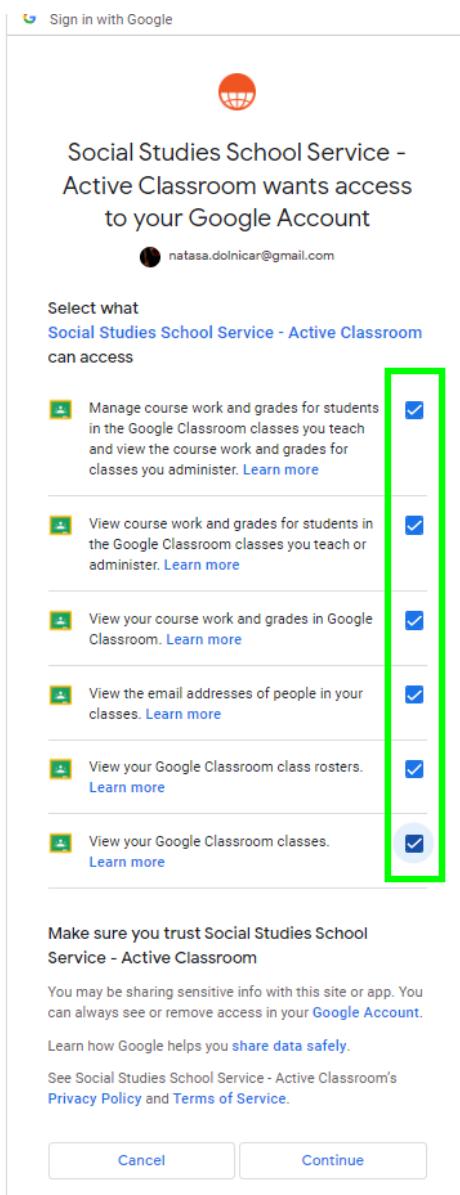
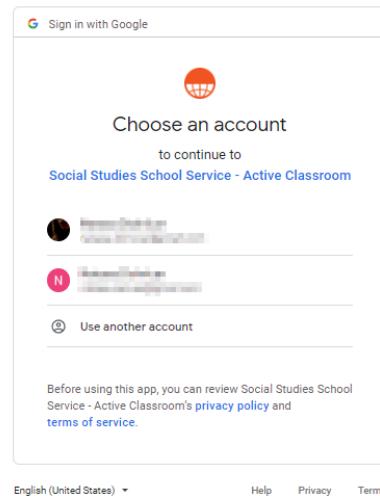
Scroll down to 'Google Classroom' section and click 'Connect to your Google Classroom account'. This is a required step to allow Active Classroom to pull class information from your Google Classroom account.



You will be sent to Google to choose your account.

Make sure to select the correct one.

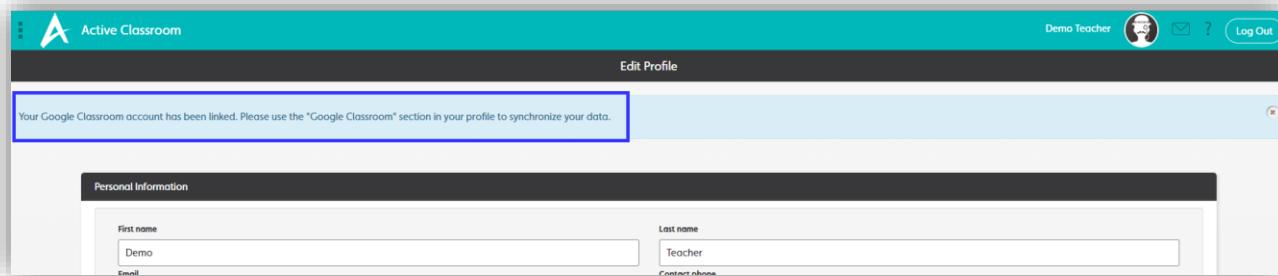
Your Active Classroom email must match the email address in your Google Classroom.



You must grant all permission to Active Classroom before clicking "Continue".

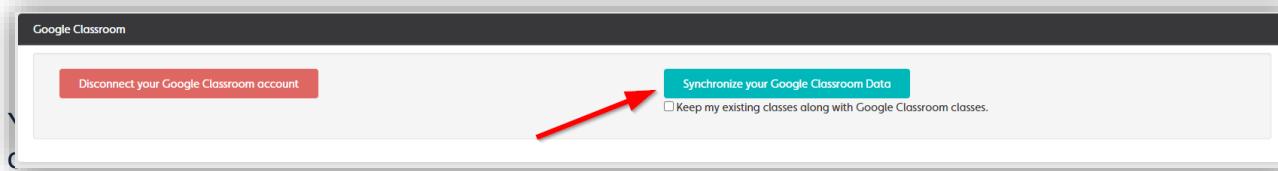
If any of the permissions are denied the connection will not work properly.

Once the permission is granted, you will be taken back to Active Classroom. You will see a message letting you know your account was connected to Google Classroom



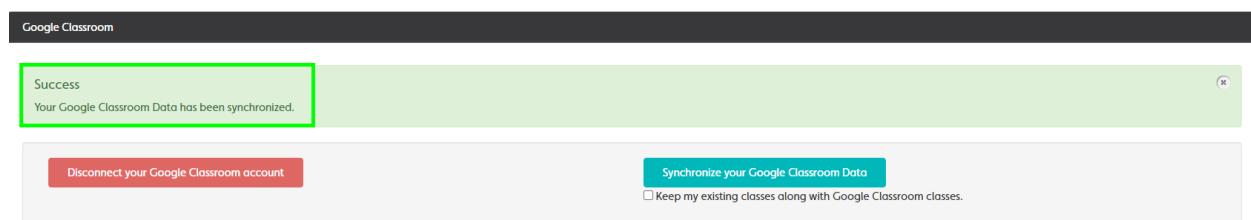
3. Synchronize your account with Google Classroom

The next step is to synchronize your Active Classroom account. Scroll back down to 'Google Classroom' section and click 'Synchronize your Google Classroom Data'.



The check box below the sync button allows you to keep existing classes along with Google Classroom classes. If you do not check this box your existing classes will be removed and replaced with classes from Google Classroom.

Please wait on the page until the sync is complete. After the process is done, you should see a green Success message in the Google Classroom section.



- If the process fails, the “sync” button will be disabled – in this case try reloading the page.
- If account gets disconnected, the informative warnings will show up, when trying different things. In this case go back to your profile and click “connect” again.

Every time you create new classes or add new students in Google Classroom you must go to your Active Classroom profile to sync the account.

Connecting AC/GC for students

1. Login to Active Classroom

Students can login on [our login page](#) with Google, or with Clever or ClassLink SSO if your district is set up for SSO.



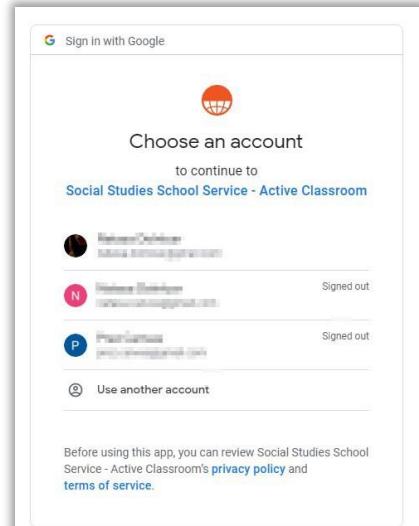
2. Connect AC/GC

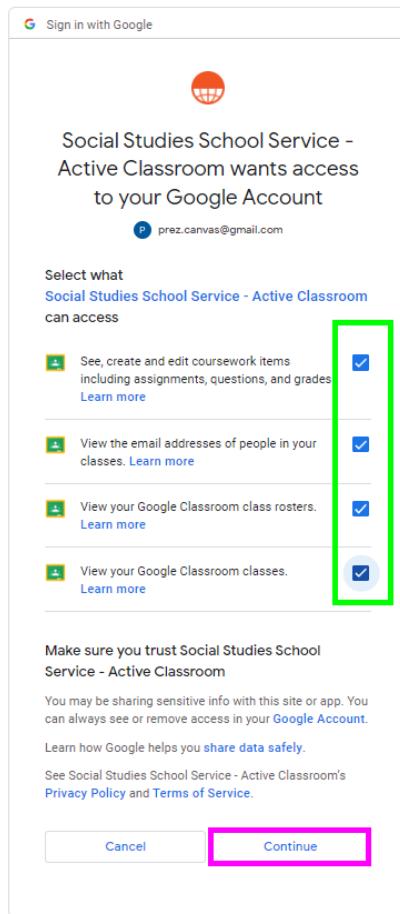
Once they are logged in, students should go to their profile and click the 'Connect to your Google Classroom Account'.



3. Student must select their Google account

It is important that students choose a correct google account
 – the one registered in their Google Classroom account.





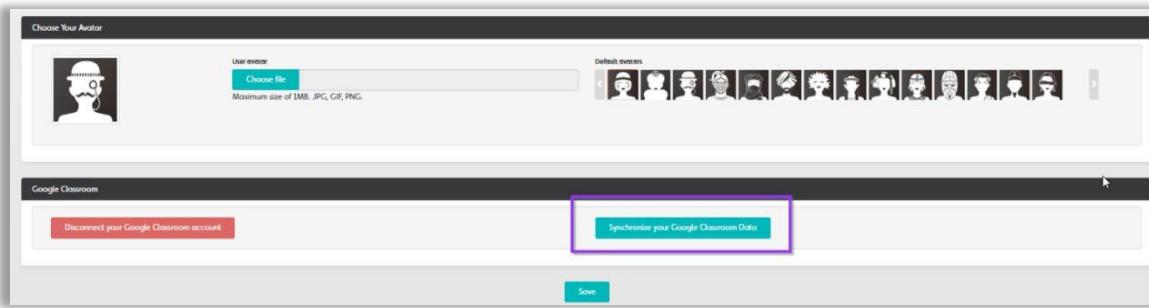
4. Grant permission

Like teachers, students will need to grant permission to activeclassroom.com

Students must check all four boxes before clicking Continue.

5. Synchronize AC/GC

After connecting AC and GC accounts, students need to “synchronize” the two accounts. Once again, they should go to their profile. They will now see a button to ‘Synchronize your Google Classroom Data’.

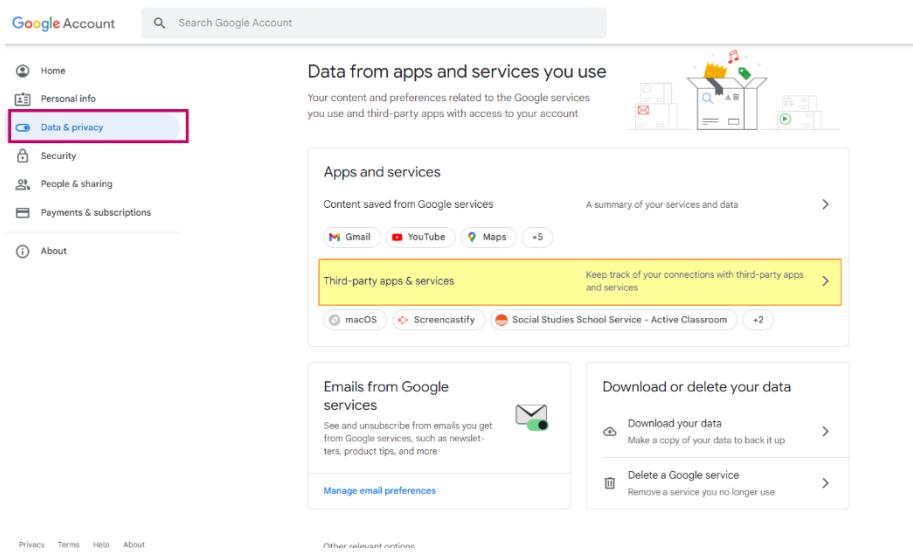


Google Classroom FAQ

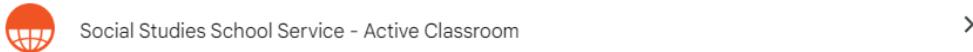

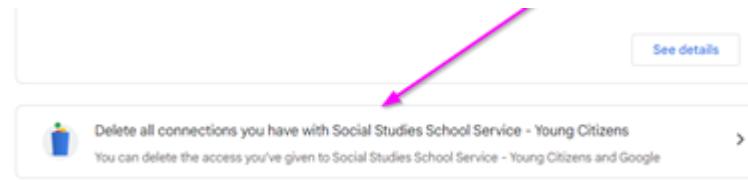
